1. Treaty= The treaties of the 1850s all outlined similar agreements. They identified the traditional territories that each tribe controlled or lived in. This legally established tribal sovereignty in each area.(pg.125)

Sovereign = The treaties recognized Indian tribes as sovereign nations.(pg.124)

Annuity= annual payments in the form of food, equipment, supplies, and funds the U.S. government owed a tribe by treaty.(pg.125)

Cede= The government also wanted the Indian tribes to cede vast regions of their land so that non-Indians could build farms, towns, and roads.(pg.125)

Ratify= A few times Congress refused to ratify treaties that had already been signed.(pg. 126)

Manifest Destiny= (the idea that the United States had a moral duty to expand its culture across the continent—see Chapter 4).(pg.131)

Emigrants = people moving from their home country to settle in a new place.(pg.133)

Indigenous = Riel led a 15-year fight for indigenous (native) rights.(pg.143)

2. Isaac Steven= was a governor of Washington Territory.(pg,128)

Victor = was a Salish chief who signed a treaty to leave the Bitterroots.(pg.128)

Red Cloud= Lakota military leader Makhpi-ah Lut-ah, whom the whites called Red Cloud.(pg.130)

Plenty Coups = was a crow leader.(pg.136)

Sitting Bull= was a Sioux Chief. (pg. 138)

Crazy Horse= was also a Sioux Chief. (pg. 138)

George Armstrong Custer = was a Lieutenant Colonel in Custer's Seventh U.S. Cavalry. (pg.138)

Charlot= was a Salish chief. (pg. 137)

Joseph= was a chief. (pg.140)

Dull Knife Dull Knife was a Northern Cheyenne leaders. (pg.142)

Nelson Miles = was a colonel in an army of 350 soldiers. (pg.141)
